The village board of trustees met Monday, and organized, with Otto Pritz as chairman. Owing to a disagreement caused by the tie vote of Aug. Evers and Herman Csen in the third ward, and the illegibility of Postmaster J. A. Knapp to serve, Mr. Pritz and Mr. Ringlee, re-elected members, appointed Geo. Bowe to fill the vacancy. H. B. Hanson, the new clerk, qualified at this meeting. J. C. Thingelstad was appointed pound master, and the appointment of a road overseer was left to be filled at a later date. A levy of \$1200 was made for general purposes, a raise of \$200 over the past two years, and a 5 mill road tax was lev-
