Attempted Murder in Broadview Freeman Curtis, residing on the Mark Curtis farm in Broadview township, and a nephew of Henry and Mark Curtis, was shot over the eye while asleep in his bed on the Who it was that fired the shot is at this writing unknown, but the authorities are investigating and it is that the criminal will soon he taken into custody. As told at the courthouse Tuesday the story is that Mr. Curtis and his housekeeper had attended a bowery dance at Karnak Monday evening and arrived home at 2 a. m. and retired. At 4 o'clock Mr. Curtis became conscious of his surroundings and thot that there was a fire in the vicinity of his head. It developed that while asleep he had been shot with a revolver over the right eye, the bullet glancing cff from the bone and traveling for some distance un-1 der the skin, coming out near the center of the forehead, but not doing any harm. The gun was held so closely that his eyebrows were singed. His housekeeper, who slept at the further end of the house, did not hear the shot, but heard him shout fire and rushed to his aid. The only clue the authorities have to work on (is a hat found in the house. Í Dr. Nolte of Dazey was called and t Mr. Curtis' injuries were attended f to. Mr. Curtis was able to come to town Tuesday forenoon and lodge 8 complaint with States Attorney Tuf-8 te, and the search for the offender i will be vigorously pushed.-Sentinel -Courier.
