

COUNTY SHOWS SOME INCREASE

Official Census Returns Give Gain of 560 People Over 1910 Census.

The official report of the population of Griggs county has been compiled by the county auditor, and it shows that, while several townships have lost in number of people since 1910, the county as a whole has made a net gain of 560. Binford was the only incorporated village or city in the county making a gain, both Hannaford and Cooperstown having less than the previous census. Sverdrup, Lenora, Tyrol, Rosendal and Romness are the townships showing a loss. It is believed that this is due largely to the number of removals to Canada, Montana and western North Dakota in the past five years.
