Hannaford Enterprise: Three years ago a representative of the game and fish commission sent to Hannaford several hundred steel head trout which were placed in the creek below town. So far as is known nothing more has been seen of that fish from that day until last Saturday when a little fellow about an inch and a half long fell out of the N. P. water tank and was picked up by Section Foreman Cederson. So it is evident that the trout are still alive and in time may increase in numbers sufficiently to make trout fishing quite a pastime in Ball Hill creek.
