Frank Layman of Hecla, S. D., who spent considerable time in Binford during the summer and who is alleged to have stolen four automobiles in the Dakotas, and was arrested and taken to Webster for trial on one of the charges, broke jail and escaped. He dug out the bricks in the jail wall. Layman procured a case knife, and with it and his fingers succeeded in removed the mortar between the bricks in the jail
