Murdered Man Found Near Luverne.

Coroner N. G. Holberg was called to the northern part of the county Monday to look after the case of a man that had evidently been killed. The body was discovered by one of the Grotberg boys, and in the opinion of the coroner the man had been dead for more than a week.

The case is evidently a murder as there were seven bullet holes in the body which had been dragged and placed under the last iron bridge on the main road to Luverne within a mile of the county line on the Barnes county side. The body was covered with hay.

There was nothing by which to identify the man as the clothing contained nothing except a small mirror and a box of matches. The remains were brought to Valley City and will be buried immediately.—Times-Record.
