

MRS. HELENA CEDERSON

The Death Angel has again visited our neighborhood and one more family is bereaved. Mrs. Helena Cederson passed away on Tuesday, April 10, at 11:05 after an illness of eight days.

Mrs. Cederson was born at Langvard, Ringsaker, Norway, Sept. 6, 1868, and attained the age of 37 years, 8 months and 4 days. She emigrated to this country and came to Hannaford where she was married to Charley Cederson, the section foreman, in 1891. Eight children were born to them, of whom five survive their mother, three having gone before. The oldest of the children will be 14 years next August and the youngest will be 3 years on June 25.

Deceased had two sisters in this country, Mrs. Mathias Johnson and Miss Thora Nelson, and a brother, Anton Nelson. They all live in this neighborhood and were able to be near when the end came.

The funeral took place at 2 o'clock Thursday. Rev. Henrik Voldal of Cooperstown officiated. The remains were interred in the Lutheran cemetery just north of town.

The ladies of Hannaford and vicinity raised a sum of money and secured a lot of flowers for the coffin; they also decorated the house and did all they could for the bereaved family. The ladies secured more money than could be used for flowers, and for the benefit of the children they gave the bereaved father the \$20.40 which was left over.

Mr. Cederson feels very grateful for all the help and sympathy extended to the family during the sickness of his wife and afterwards. It was truly a great comfort and help and he is unable to express how much it meant to him.
