

MRS. KNUT KALVIK.

DIED—At her home five miles east of Hannaford, April 26, 1907 Ingeborg Kalvik, beloved wife of Knut Kalvik.

Mrs. Knut Kalvik was born in Stannes Prestegjeld, Norway about 50 years ago where she lived until her marriage with Knut Kalvik. In the early eighties Mr. and Mrs. Kalvik settled on their homestead a few miles east of town and have been living there ever since.

Mrs. Kalvik has for a number of years been a sufferer from kidney trouble and this was what finally resulted in her death.

Deceased leaves a husband and three children to mourn the loss of a loving wife and mother. Mrs. Asmund Oppeboen, is the oldest of the children, and was present at the bedside of her dying mother, though her husband had gone to Canada some time before. Olaf, about 15 years old, and Hilda, about 12 years old, are the other children.

The funeral occurred Monday afternoon, conducted by Rev. Voldal, and the burial took place in the Union cemetery.
