

DEATH OF MRS. HELGE W. HAUGE

PASSED TO HER LONG REST YESTERDAY MORNING AFTER A MONTHS ILLNESS WITH CANCER.

Mrs. Helge W. Hauge was relieved of the pain and suffering of this life at 3:30 yesterday morning and passed peacefully to her long reward. She had been a sufferer from cancer and for the past month suffered a great deal of pain, but bore it all with fortitude.

Aggie Sand was born in Norway on June 24, 1869, and came to America and to North Dakota twenty years ago last June, when she came to Northwood, Grand Forks county to reside with an uncle. On July 11, 1894, she was married to Mr. Helge W. Hauge and eleven years ago they moved to this vicinity where they have since resided. To them were born three children, Anne Gissina, 13 years old; Wilhelm Severin, 10 years, and Henry Olaf, 2 years, and these with the husband and father and one sister, Miss Mary Sand, are left to mourn her demise.
