

George House Dead

George House, who resided three miles north of Kensal, just over the line in Foster county, died on Thursday morning of last week after more than a year's illness. He first had some stomach trouble and went to the hot springs in Canada but without receiving any benefit. He was latter taken with typhoid-pneumonia and from this he never fully recovered, having suffered one or two relapses.

Mr. House was one of the old timers in this part of North Dakota having come here before the railroad and when there were but few settlers in the country. He was a man of good and kindly disposition and was highly respected by everyone. He was a member of the I. O. O. F., M. W. A. and the Masonic fraternity.

The funeral was held on Saturday afternoon and was conducted by the Masons of Carrington, the remains being laid to rest in the Kensal cemetery.

Mrs. House is also in a rather critical condition and physicians hold out little hope of her recovery.
