

DEATH OF OLD RESIDENT

GOTTLIEB SCHULTZ DIED ON FRIDAY AT THE JAMESTOWN HOSPITAL AT THE AGE OF SIXTY FIVE.

After a sickness of several weeks and treatment at Valley City and Jamestown hospitals, Gottlieb Schultz, one of the older residents of the county and farmers, residing near Spiritwood lake, died at the Jamestown hospital this morning. Death was due to heart disease. Mr. Schultz was 65 years of age and has for many years followed the occupation of farming on his land just west of Spiritwood lake. He was unmarried, and was born in Europe, and was well known to many of the older residents and farmers of the country. His sister and brother-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Michael Frenzel, who have resided in the vicinity of the lake, are now spending the winter in Germany. Mr. Schultz was a kindly, cheerful man and a good citizen. One of his favorite occupations was that of fishing in a certain spot on the South shore of Spiritwood lake. As the "old fisherman" of the lake he will be missed by many visitors at that resort.

The funeral will be held in Jamestown and burial here.—
