

## School Notes.

The Courtenay public school opens Monday, Sept. 7.

Monday being a legal holiday, school will be in session only long enough for the organization of classes and assignment of lessons.

All first year pupils of the high school are requested to bring their eighth grade finals; all others, any high school credits that they may have.

As previously announced the following teachers will have charge of the work for the coming year: Misses Follansbee, Palmer, Hutchinson, Scott and Cravath. Superintendent and principal of the high school, W. H. Otterburn.

The work in the grades will be conducted in accordance with the course of study prescribed by the state department for the graded schools of North Dakota. This will make the grade work of the Courtenay city schools uniformly the same in kind and quality as as the grade work in all the city schools of the state.

Opportunity in the high school will be given to do three years of regular high school work. In the accomplishment of this work the regulations and requirements of the state high school board will be carefully observed. This will set the same standard for the pupils of the Courtenay high school as is set for the pupils of the best high schools of the state. They will pursue the same subjects, take the same examinations and receive the same state certificates of completion. If at any time they desire to further their education by doing work at any of the higher state institutions of learning, the state completion certificates received here will admit them without further examination.
