Shot by Negro

On Sunday morning about 3:30 two negroes attempted to hold up the crew on a freight train at Rogers and Brakeman W. A. Fly was shot twice in the arm and quite severely injured. The train was taking water and Fly started to walk to the front end of the train when a big husky negro stepped out from between the cars and shoved a gun under his nose and ordered him to surrender his valuables. Fly reached for his own gun but before he could use it the negro fired. The wounded man was taken to Leal and his wounds dressed and he was then taken to Enderlin.

The negroes made good their escape and have not yet been apprehended.
