He was 3 badly cut about the head and face and left insensible, after his 1 pockets had been riffled. He was 1 found and brought to the city) where he received medical aid. C He is not dangerously hurt but t is badly bruised and cut about 8 3 the head. He contends that his 3 assailants secured stones and beat him with them. ľ Fried can give no description ľ ì t of the men beyond that one was 9 short and the other tall.
