

## MAN HELD UP AND ROBBED

GILLIAN FRIED, A NEPHEW OF  
ANTON FRIED, BADLY TREATED  
AT VALLEY CITY.

Saturday night Gillian Fried, a harvest hand and thresher, was set upon by two men in the northern part of this city and badly beaten and robbed of \$40. Fried had been working with a threshing crew at Wimbledon and yesterday quit work and came down Saturday night on the Soo, enroute east to the woods where he intends to work this winter. He picked up two companions on the way down from Wimbledon and after arriving they started to walk over town from North Valley City. When just beyond the Northern Pacific viaduct they set upon Fried and gave him a terrible beating with stones. He was badly cut about the head and face and left insensible, after his pockets had been rifled. He was found and brought to the city where he received medical aid. He is not dangerously hurt but is badly bruised and cut about the head. He contends that his assailants secured stones and beat him with them.

Fried can give no description of the men beyond that one was short and the other tall. The local authorities have been unable to find any clew to the two men. — Valley City Times-Record.
