

Eskil Olson again demonstrated his ability as a wrestler when he succeeded in winning the match from the Dago Kid at Larson's opera house Thanksgiving afternoon. The Dago Kid came touted as a champion and holder of a silver belt and would have been minus both had it not been that the match was held at catch weights. Olson won the first and third falls in 12 and 17 minutes respectively, while the Dago Kid won the second in 7 minutes.
