

## A Reckless Lineman

In order to win a wager from a friend, C. A. Moseman, a local lineman at Edgeley, performed a stunt here this evening which was probably never equalled in the northwest under the same conditions. Mounting the flagpole on top of the roller mill in all about 75 feet from the ground, he balanced himself on his head.
