

Cashier Loran Nichols of the First National Bank received 25 of the new Lincoln pennies the fore part of the week and has distributed them among patrons of the bank. They are the first to arrive here and will undoubtedly be the last, as the mintage of the pennies has been stopped by the government, owing to the designer's initials being too prominent. The profile of Lincoln appears on one side of the penny while the reverse side is ornamented with two heads of wheat, in itself a tribute to the wheat raising country.
