

IMPROVING LINES

THE N. W. TELEPHONE CO. REPLACING IRON WIRES WITH HEAVY COPPER WIRE.

In addition to the two Northwestern Telephone Company construction cars, which arrived yesterday, for work on the new line between Jamestown and LaMoure, two others cars of the same kind arrived today, and will be sent to Carrington for the work of stringing a new line of copper wire from Carrington to Anamoose on the Soo, a distance of about 60 miles.

The new telephone line to Adrain and LaMoure will replace the old iron wire with a first class copper wire. Work will be rushed on this extension and first class service installed between Jamestown and LaMoure.

Mr. Wheeldon of the Dakota Electric Construction Co., is arranging to start repair and extension work on the Spiritwood lake line, and that line will shortly be put in good condition, thoroughly overhauled, also several additional phones put in.—Alert.
