relation which has existed for the past three years. Mr. Riddle has been connected with the church for nearly three and a half years and during that time the church has gone for-ward and made better progaess

along all lines than at any time in the history of the institution. He has preached 330 sermons, has attended 26 funerals, married 10 couples, has received in salary anything-\$45.00.

\$3,016.00, received in donations \$452.05, marriage fees \$88.00, from funerals-only five paying During that period the church and congregation has raised for all purposes, except for bene-volences, the sum of \$5,245.00. For benevolences the church has given the sum of \$560.85, making the total the church has given for all purposes during his pastorate the encouraging sum of \$5,805.85-almost \$6,000.00. 3 It may be well said, "Well е done, good and faithful servant. 1
