

GONE TO VALLEY CITY

DR. A. W. MACDONALD HAS FORMED A PARTNERSHIP WITH DR. PLATOU AT VALLEY CITY AND HAS GONE THERE TO TAKE UP THE PRACTICE.

Dr. Macdonald came to Courtenay from Chicago in 1897 and engaged in the drug business in connection with the practice of medicine. As the country settled up he found that his practice increased until he found it necessary to dispose of the drug business, which he did about seven years ago, when he sold out to H. J. Murphy, and has since devoted his entire time to his medical practice. He has always kept abreast of the times and has taken a post graduate course yearly at Chicago in one of the leading institutions of the country and once went to New Orleans where he took a post graduate course in the New Orleans Polyclinic. For the past four years he has been railroad surgeon for the Soo Line, was county coroner for two years and for the past seven years has been a member of the school board where he rendered valuable service to the district, for two years being president of the board. He was also a member of the village council shortly after the town was incorporated as a village and has been connected with every public enterprise of any moment since he has been here. He will move his family to Valley City as soon as he can find a suitable residence.
