

The news that Wm. Gallivan died very suddenly last week, Thursday, at his home at Milk River, Alberta, reached here by a telegram received by George Tucker and Mrs. O. A. Lohrke last Friday who immediately left for that place to attend the funeral which was to be held Tuesday of this week. Meagre reports received here fail to give the direct cause of his death.
