DEATH OF DUNCAN PATTERSON

o'clock, the father of M. D. Patterson, who has been staying with his son for some time, was called by the grim reaper of death. Mr. Patterson was 89 years old, his 90th birthday coming in the fall and his death was pronounced due to old age.

He was born in Isla, Scotland,

Nov. 26, 1820, and immigrated to Canada in 1843. On April 12th, 1848, he married Marion Johnson and together they moved to this state in the spring of 1882. He leaves three sons and one daughter to mourn his loss, J. J. Patterson of Lang, Alta.; D. A. Patterson of Hibbing, Minn.; M. D. Patterson of Courtenay.; and Mrs. W. R. Splan, of Superior, Wis., all of whom have been notified of his death but is not known whether they will be able to attend the funeral or not.
