TWO DEATHS OCCUR WITHIN A FEW DAYS. INTERMENT IN COURTENAY CEMETERY.

Mrs. William Wilson passed away Saturday evening at the home of her son, Frank W. Wilson, on the farm north of town at the age of 77 years, 11 months and 19 days, surrounded by her remaining children, who were at her bedside to comfort the mother in the last hours of her life. Funeral services were held at the farm home of her son and many gathered to attend the last sad rites. Rev. J. W. Kingston spoke comforting words to the relatives and friends of the departed and held the services. Interment was made in the Courtenay cemetery Monday afternoon shortly after the funeral services were closed, where the last remains of all that is mortal were laid to rest.

Deceased was born in Devonshire, England, in 1833 and lived there until about eight years ago when she moved to this country and had since made her home with her son, Frank W. Wilson, and part of the time with her daughter, Mrs. C. H. Prosser, who, besides a brother, are the only remaining living children of six that were born to her. Her husband died in England a little over fourteen years ago and only a few years before she immigrated to this country to pass the remaining days of her life with her children.
