A week from next Monday the lower rooms of the Courtenay High school will again be opened for school work. The rooms were closed last Monday on account of several mild cases of 1 smallpox and it was thought best to close the lower rooms to permit thorough fumigation and until all danger of contagion was 1 past. The two cases of smallpox reported were those of the Alswager children who had an attack in a very mild form and it 1 is thought that no serious results 6 will follow unless complications 1 set in. With the prevalence of smallpox in this vicinity it would e be highly advisable to be vaccinn ated unless successful vaccina-1 e tion has been made not longer The than seven years ago. e board of health may take steps 1 to order vaccination if such 1 n course should be deemed necesd
