

A week from next Monday the lower rooms of the Courtenay High school will again be opened for school work. The rooms were closed last Monday on account of several mild cases of smallpox and it was thought best to close the lower rooms to permit thorough fumigation and until all danger of contagion was past. The two cases of smallpox reported were those of the Alswager children who had an attack in a very mild form and it is thought that no serious results will follow unless complications set in. With the prevalence of smallpox in this vicinity it would be highly advisable to be vaccinated unless successful vaccination has been made not longer than seven years ago. The board of health may take steps to order vaccination if such course should be deemed necessary.
