

WHOLE FAMILY GETS TYPHOID

CONTAMINATED WELL WAS THE CAUSE FOR DISEASE—SEVEN IN FAMILY IN HOSPITAL.

Jamestown, N. D., March 8. — Mrs. A. L. Demery, seven members of whose family have been stricken with typhoid fever in the last few months, was taken to the city hospital today. She is not affected with the fever in this case, however.

Mrs. Demery, with a daughter and son, were taken to the hospital last October; and the son's case proved fatal a short time after. Since that time the father and three other children of the family, have been at the hospital one after another, until the little 6-year-old daughter, Edith, was received a few days ago as the patient of the group previous to the mother's present illness. The girl is still in the hospital, although her condition is not considered serious.

The cause of the typhoid cases has been located by the city health officer in the well from which the family took its drinking water. The house has also been moved to higher ground for further protection.
