Mr. and Mrs. John Falk returned yesterday morning from Scott, Sask., from an extended visit with the latter's parents who are engaged in farming in that vicinity. Mr. Falk states that never before has he seen a stand of grain equal to that to be seen in the Scott and Saskatoon territory in Saskatchewan. It will, however, take a month more to ripen the grain, which, as a rule, is hardly out of blossom and the returns of the crops will depend entirely on the nonappearance of killing frosts which are liable to occur at any time during August and early Septemher.
