A. J. Gorthy had the misfortune to have two young horses run over by a Soo train last Thursday night. They had escaped from the pasture on one of his farms and in straying across the country were caught by a train and fatally injured, making it necessary to have them killed to put them out of their misery. It is not exactly known which train ran over them but it is thought that perhaps train No. 108, which comes through shortly after four o'clock in the morning, caught the poor animals while crossing the track ahead of the train. It is expected that the railroad company will settle for the value of the horses killed,
