In a letter to his family the Rev. J. W. Kingston writes from Rochester, Minn., that after a thorough examination by the corps of physicians at the hospital of the Mayo brothers it was found that he was suffering from a complication of ailments consisting of ulceration of the intestines and other troubles. Upon the advice of the physicians an operation for the removal of the parts affected was performed but it is not definitely known with what results. His many friends here hope for the best.
