

Fire destroyed the barn of John E. Lange, who lives near Spiritwood lake, Thursday of last week. Everything inside of the barn was saved, but two wagons standing near by were burned before it was noticed that they were in danger of catching on fire. No insurance was had on the building and wagons. The origin of the fire was caused by smoldering ashes of a nearby straw stack which had been set on fire a few days previous and which was thought to be entirely burned out. The barn has been rebuilt, the lumber being hauled shortly after the building was destroyed. The farm is occupied by Ed. Lange, a son of the owner.
