Otto Lohrke found his horses, which estrayed from his barn over a month ago, near Lakota, N. D. A farmer had taken the estrays and advertised the fact but had not fully complied with the North Dakota estray law. The farmer had also used the horses for field and road work throughout the time he had them in his possession which is contrary to the provisions of the law covering such cases and in sequence made himself liable to a fine imposed for such illegal
