The case of Mrs. Mansfield vs. Anton Scheler, which was to be tried before Justice Bouer last Thursday, was called at 10 a. m. The state, for the plaintiff, decided to change the charge originally preferred against the defendant, from that of using obscene language in public places to slander of a female. The case was bound over to the county court and will be heard before County Judge J. U. Hemmi during the next term of the court sometime this fall. It is thought, however, that the case might be settled amicably before that time.
