

Tramp Near Death

in Jamestown Pond

Jamestown, N. D., June 24.—J. H. Perry, a transient, aged about 45 years, came near finding a watery grave in the Pipestem late Wednesday afternoon. He was swimming alone near the stock yards when he was suddenly overcome by cramps, sinking several times. Two boys, walking on the shore of the river, saw a man's head bobbing up and down in the water, and Dougherty plunged in and pulled the body to shore. Assistance was obtained from the round house and men worked over the body from five o'clock until seven, when Perry was finally resuscitated.
