BOUND OVER

CARL E. PETERSON WAS
ARRAIGNED ON A CHARGE OF
DISPOSING OF MORTGAGED
PROPERTY AND BOUND TO
THE DISTSICT COURT.

Justice George E. Bouer's court was

occupied on Saturday with the trial of Carl E. Peterson who was arrested by E. L. Skaar on the charge of disposing of grain on which Mr. Skaar had a mortgage and burning up the granary in an effort to cover up the alleged theft. Mr. Peterson has had Mr. Skaar's farm rented and this is the same grain over which the gentlemen had the trouble a short time ago and Mr. Peterson was put under bonds to keep the peace. But this is a great deal more serious charge this time and Justice Bouer considered evidence sufficient to warrant binding Mr. Peterson to the district court and fixed his bond at \$300, which was promptly furnished.
