

## PETER AGNIMSON DEAD.

THE FATHER OF THE PETERSON BOYS PASSED AWAY ON MONDAY OF THIS WEEK AT THE AGE OF EIGHTY YEARS.

Peter Agnimson, father of the Peterson boys, died on Monday of this week at the age of eighty years, the cause of death being asthma and old age.

Mr. Agnimson was born in Norway in June of 1825 and came to Wisconsin in 1855 where he lived for five years and then moved to Minnesota where he lived for twenty years. Believing that there were better things in store for him farther west he moved to South Dakota where he lived for twenty-two years and came to North Dakota in 1902 and settled on the Henning farm north of town where he has since resided. He was a good man and had a host of friends among his acquaintances. He had been afflicted with asthma for some time and life became a burden instead of a blessing.

The funeral was held at the house on Wednesday and the remains were laid to rest in the Courtenay cemetery.

Besides his wife he leaves three sons, Stephen, Andrew and Ole to mourn his death. The sympathy of friends in this community is extended to the family in their bereavement.
