DR. ARCHIBALD DROWNED

DR. O. W. ARCIBALD WAS DROWNED IN HIS BATH TUB AT ST. PAUL LAST FRIDAY.

Dr. O. W. Archibald, formerly superintendent of the state hospital for the
insane at Jamestown was drowned at
his home in St. Paul last Friday while
taking a bath. He had not been well
for some time and it is thought that
the cold plunge caused him to take a
cramp and his life was sniffed out before aid could reach him. He had just
returned from a visit with friends at
Jamestown and the news of his death
came as a great surprise.

Dr. Archibald was the first superintendent for the North Dakota hospital for the insane situated at Jamestown and so continued until 1895, when he was succeeded by Dr. D. S. Moore, the present superintendent, who had been his assistant physician for a number of years. After leaving Jamestown Mr. Archibald located in St. Paul where he has made a specialty of diseases of the eye and ear and has made a fine success. He was of a very genial disposition and was liked by all who became acquainted with him. Besides a widow and two children in St. Paul he leaves two children, Mrs.
