

## Death of Mrs. Colby

Mrs. Adelia Colby, widow of the late W. H. Colby, died at 11 a. m. today at the residence of her daughter, Mrs. B. T. Broughton, East Front street. She has been ill since last Thanksgiving with catarrh of the stomach. She was one of the old residents of the county, residing for about 14 years near Ypsilanti, for three years on the Birks farm north of the city and for several years on the Wallace farm east of Jamestown.

Mrs. W. H. Colby was born 73 years ago near Hudson, N. Y., her parents being old time Yankees of New England stock. In Wolcott, N. Y., she married Mr. Colby and for a time lived in Ypsilanti, Michigan, before coming to Ypsilanti, N. D. in 1881. It was seven years ago while living on the Birks farm north of the city that her husband died. Before coming to North Dakota Mrs. Colby was a member of the Baptist church but being distant from church privileges did not become affiliated with any organization here.

Two sons, Frank and Edwin Colby, and one daughter, Mrs. B. T. Broughton of this city reside here.—Capital.
