

Burned in Iowa

The residents of the eastern Stutsman and western Barnes counties will regret to hear of the tragic death of Andrew Hinsperger, an old timer who has resided near Eckelson for about 22 years. He had gone to Iowa to purchase a blooded horse and was returning with the animal in a freight train when a collision occurred with a passenger train in Iowa on Wednesday night. In the wreck that followed, the caboose was burned and Mr. Hinsperger was burned to death and the body has not been identified from that of several others burned in the same wreck. Pious Strong of Sanborn left Thursday night to identify the remains if possible. Mr. Hinsperger was one of the best known men in that part of the county and was a self made man, coming to the county with nothing but \$1.25 and will leave an estate worth from \$25,000 to \$30,000. One of the deceased children was attending the St John's Academy and was sent home yesterday. —Alert.
