

Death of Mrs. McGuire

Mrs. Thomas McGuire died at the home of her sister, Mrs. Anton Baenen, at Jamestown, on Wednesday, January 24th. She had been ill for about two months, the trouble beginning with erysipelas, other complications following.

Miss Anna Neidecker was married to Thomas McGuire on February 23d, 1903, and shortly afterwards they began farming about eight miles southwest of Courtenay on Charles Schumacher's farm and lived there until a short time ago. Before her marriage Miss Neidecker taught school for several years and made many friends throughout the county. She also resided in Courtenay for a time and all who knew her loved her for her gentle and kind disposition, always looking to the welfare of others. Her sisters Rosa, Hattie and Mary Ellen Neidecker and Mrs. Baenen reside at Jamestown, while two other sisters are at some distance and her father resides in Nebraska.

The funeral was held from the Catholic church at Jamestown on Friday at 10 a. m.
