
Death of John Ochsner

Mr. John Ochsner, one of the county's most highly esteemed and exemplary farmers, died of diebetis at his home eight miles north of Medina Friday morning. Mr. Ochsner came to Medina from Scotland, South Dakota in the spring of 1900. He purchased a section of land, and at once built up and opened a fine farm.
