JOHN SEILER DEAD

PASSED TO THE GREAT BEYOND ON SATURDAY MORNING AF-TER AN ILLNESS OF ONLY A FEW DAYS.

John Seiler died at his home southwest of town on Saturday morning, February 25th, about ten o'clock. He had been ill but a few days and death was entirely unexpected. About a week previous he had an attack of what seemed to be pneumonia but he did not consider himself sick enough to employ a physician and told his wife that he would be all right again in a day or two. On Friday night before his death he seemed to be well and on Saturday morning he did not feel so well and laid on the couch for some time and then went out in the room where his wife was churning and talked with her for a short time and then returned and again laid down on the couch and when his wife went to see him a short time later she was horrified to find that he was dead. The coroner was notified and held an autopsy on Sunday and pronounced the cause of death to be tubercolosis.

Mr Seiler was a German by birth and came to North Dakota from Illinois about two years ago and moved out in the country where he has since resided. He was fifty-six years old last July and was a stone mason by trade and was a good workman. Besides his wife he leaves a step son who is now in Seattle, Washington, to mourn his untimely demise.

About a year ago he was persuaded to take a life insurance policy in the Germania Life Insurance Company and had only paid one premium on the same.

The funeral was held on Monday of this week and interrment took place in the German Lutheran cemetery west of town.
