

Lambert Smith, Sr., died on Saturday at his home at Foston, Minn., and the remains were taken to Jamestown for burial. He was 89 years old and was among the early settlers at Jamestown, moving there in 1879. He was a blacksmith and had his shop in the rear of the Alert office when that paper was edited by Marshall McClure, and while McClure wrote editorials Smith pounded out horseshoes.
