A man by the name of Charles E. Wilhelm, a traveling salesman, was instantly killed at the Soo crossing east of Kensal last week Thursday evening by train No. 107. He had been out in the country all day and was just returning to town and as he crossed the track the train struck him and he was instantly killed. It was evident that the train struck about the center of the rig as the man was inside of the top in front of the engine on the cow catcher.
