Ole Hogenson, an unmarried man, living in the Jessie neighborhood, was found dead in bed Monday morning by Frank Pfeifer and O. E. Thorn. He had promised to help these gentlemen haul grain or do some other work, and being always punctual in keeping his appointments and not putting in an appearance, they went to his place and found him lying dead in bed, undressed, in just about the shape he retired. Coroner Kerr and Sheriff Greenland went up Tuesday morning and held the inquest. As near as can be learned he died from some heart trouble.
