

John J. Strande, a brother of Mrs. John O. Oie, died last Friday night, after a brief struggle with typhoid fever. The deceased had been ailing for two or three weeks but did not get real sick until about a week before he died. He came to Griggs county in the spring of 1888, and the last five years had been farming in Nelson county. He was about 39 years old. He was an exemplary young man and was a hard worker. The funeral took place from Mr. Oie's house Sunday afternoon, and the funeral sermon was preached at the grave in the cemetery, where his remains were laid to rest, by Rev. E. T. Silness. The death of her brother has been a heavy blow to Mrs. Oie and her numerous friends sincerely sympathize with her and the rest of the family in their affliction.
