Married-At Oberon, N. D., May 31, 1896, by the Rev. O. P. Champlin, Tiwaste Young and Tunkankeiyotonkewin (Sitting-With-Stone-Girl), all of the Ft. Totten Indian reservation. The bride, a widow, with a boy two years old, was baptized into the christian faith just prior to the marriage ceremony. Her age is seventeen years. The groom-forty-three years of age, is a christian Indian. The ceremony was performed at the parsonage. A lunch was served afterwards-the bride taking hers outdoors at the wagon. The witnesses were Charles W. Shielde, who acted as interpreter, and Job Twobearts. Samuel Tiwaste buried his wife sometime last year.
