Frederic Widlund, brother of Al. Widlund, narrowly escaped death last Saturday morning from the accidental discharge of a gun while out hunting. The gun was loaded and both barrels cocked and in taking it from the buggy one of the barrels was discharged the charge striking Widlund's eighth rib and breaking it. Dr. Bergstrom was summoned and reports that while the young man was pretty well shot up, he did not think that the conditions were serious. We learn later that the young man is getting along nicely. This should be a warning to sportsmen to see that their guns are unloaded before getting into a buggy or any other vehicle. It is a dangerous as well as foolhardy practice.
