## Victims of the Storm.

DEVILS DAKE, N. D., Dec. 1,—The body of Henry M. Burrows, the mail clerk who was lost in the storm at Devils Lake, was found yesterday on the flats southeast of the city about half a mile from the city. The supposition is that the unfortunate man had got past the train, being unable to see in the blinding storm, and had then wandered blindly on till his strength gave out.

Carrington, N. D., Dec. 1.—D. C. McKeever, a farmer, was found yesterday north of Kensel, frozen to death.

Grand Forks, N. D., Dec. 1.—During the storm a farmer at Leeds, N. D. started out for a load of poles for a shed and failed to return. His body, and those of his horses were found the next day, almost buried in a snow drift and frozen stiff.
