Mayville, N. D., April 19.—Dr. G. O. Greftegreff, a veterinary surgeon of this place, took through mistake an ounce of arsenious acid and caustic potash. After suffering terrible agonies for thirty hours he died early this morning. Five of the best doctors in the county worked with him continually but their efforts were in vain as the deadly poison could not be counteracted. Mr. Greftegreff was a young man and with the exception of one sister who lives at Northwood, this state, his family and relations are in Norway. He was a graduate of Copenhagen, Denmark, veterinary college, and was one of the brightest and best informed veterinarians in the state. His relatives have been cabled an account of his death and it is very probable that his remains will be sent to his old home for interment. His many friends in this state will be shocked to learn of his death, and his family have the heartfelt sympathy of every citizen of Mayville.
